



Duquesne Light Company is seeking input on a proposed electric transmission project to improve reliability within the electric transmission system in Penn Hills, Monroeville, Plum Borough, and the surrounding areas. The Company proposes construction of a new 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line between the Universal and Plum Substations.

Duquesne Light Company has developed preliminary study corridors based on publically available data. Public input is desired to assist in identifying a preferred alternative. The Company will host an informal public workshop from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. on:

- Thursday, October 20th at the Garden City Fire Hall in Monroeville.
