Documentation, certified by a registered professional engineer to show that the cumulative effect of any
	proposed development within AE Area/District without floodway when combined with all other existing and anticipated development, will not increase the base flood elevation more than (1) foot at any point. A document certified by a registered professional engineer which states that the proposed construction has been adequately designed to withstand the pressures, velocities, impact, and uplift forces associated with the base flood.
_	Such statement shall include a description of the type and extent of flood proofing measures which have been incorporated into the design of the structure and/or development.  Detail of the design and construction standards indicating compliance with sections 5.03 and 5.04 of the Floodplain Ordinance and details indicating compliance with the applicable sections of the PA Uniform Construction Code.  A plan is required for any proposed excavation or grading showing compliance with the DEP requirements for erosion and sedimentation control.
