Plum Boro Police officers will continue to respond to all emergencies and conduct all routine patrol and investigative functions. The Police Department will continue to serve the citizens of Plum Borough on a 24/7, 365 day a year basis. Residents, visitors and motorists are still encouraged to call 911 to request police services. Effective immediately the Plum Police Department has implemented the following changes to our standard operating procedures.

The Plum Police Department will be screening non-emergency calls for service to determine if such calls can be managed without face-to-face contact. Non-emergency calls for service are defined as nuisance issues such as noise or parking complaints, incidents that did not just occur or are not currently active, questions regarding police services and advisements, any non-violent crimes such as fraud or identity theft. Patrol supervisors will review all non-emergency calls for service and determine if the issue can be addressed with a phone call from an on-duty officer. If the reason for your call cannot be managed over the phone, a Plum Police officer will respond to your location as usual.

Officers who have initiated traffic stops during this event have been advised to issue any warnings or citations via the U.S. Postal Service instead of prolonging any unnecessary interaction with the occupants of the stopped vehicle.

Any records requests such as incident reports or crash reports will be made by appointment only on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays between the hours of 11:00am – 3:00pm. Please call 412-795-6800 extension 4370 to schedule an appointment.

The Plum Police Department is taking a proactive stance by making these modifications during this event to ensure the safety and health of our community as well as our officers.
